## What is the iCloud



Data stored in remote locations via the Internet became known as Cloud storage. Apple named its storage the iCloud.

Storing your data in the iCloud allows all your devices to sync with each other.



Apple has storage facilities in more than 40 countries called Data Centers.




## Settings for iCloud




## iPhone Backup

2. Scroll to iCloud, tap.




## iPhone Backup
