

# FaceTime - iPhone - iOS 17

## What is FaceTime?

An app for making video & voice calls over the internet.



### Prerequisites

- Signed into your Apple ID account.
- Connected to the internet, Wi-Fi or cellular.
- FaceTime setup

## Operation

- Defaults to using Wi-Fi, no additional cost.
- Cellular data (If allowed in Settings > Cellular > FaceTime).
- On cellular, counts against data plan.
- Does not count against minutes.

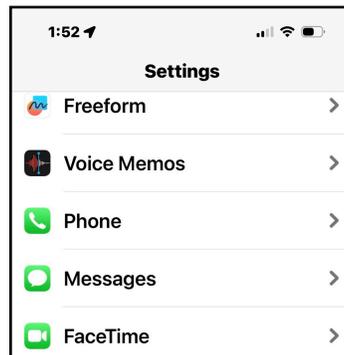
## FaceTime Setup



Open Settings

Scroll to FaceTime and tap

Ensure FaceTime is turned on. Look at other settings as well.

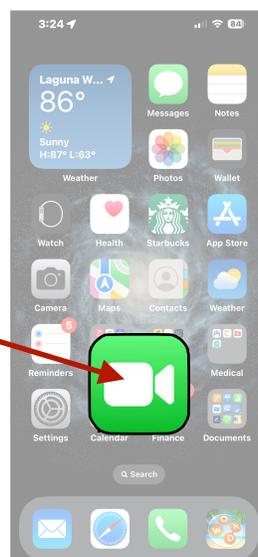

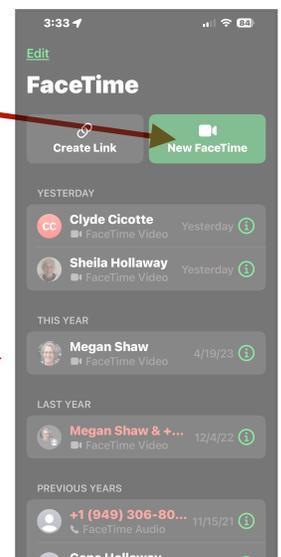
## Making a FaceTime Call

## Making a FaceTime Call

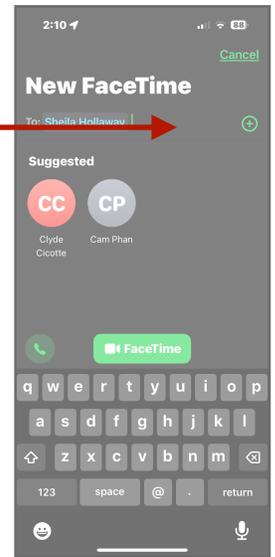
Tap, type recipient

Take a Live Photo

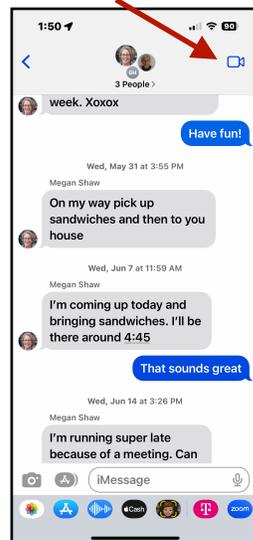

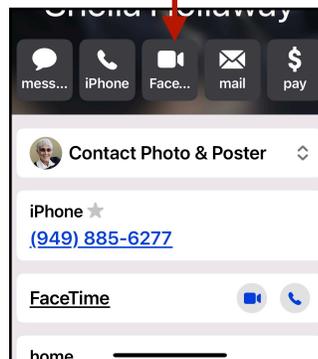
