Importance of Medical ID

- Medical ID allows first responders access to your medical info from locked screen w/o needing your passcode.
- They can see your medical info and Emergency Contacts.

Preliminary Setup

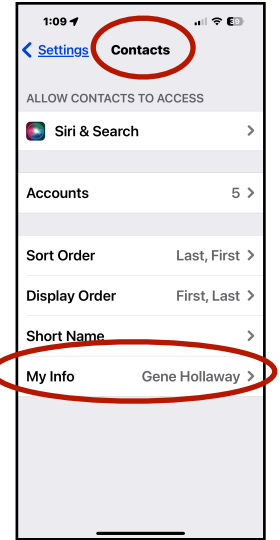
1. Tap Settings

3. Make sure your name is here



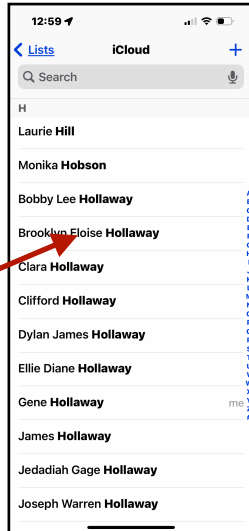

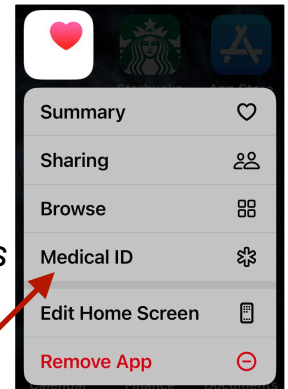

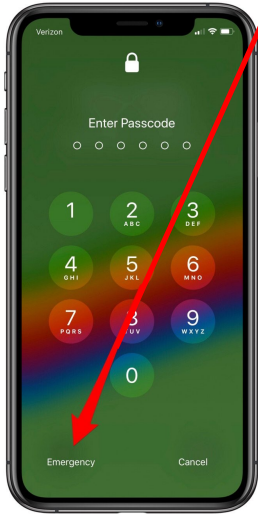

- Tapping Emergency, opens the phone and option to see Medical ID.

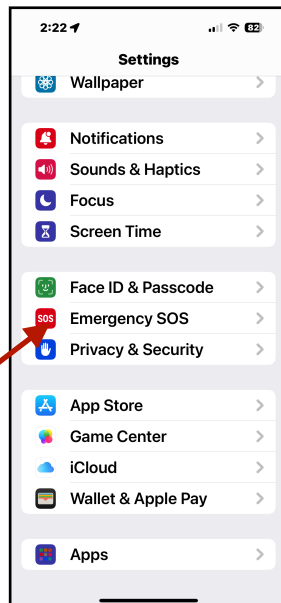

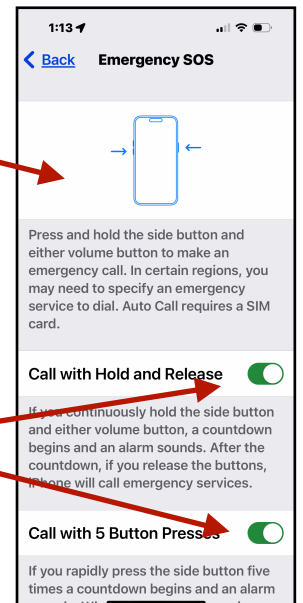

How it Works
