

Passkeys: Replacement for Passwords




Passwords



- Hard to remember
- Often reused
- Shared secret


Passkeys:



- A passwordless sign-in experience.
- Always strong, nothing to remember.
- No shared secrets, resistant to phishing.
- Works across all Apple devices.

Two-Factor Authentication (Prerequisite)

- Tap Settings. 
- Tap your name (at top of page).
- Tap Sign-in & Security.
- Ensure Two-Factor Authentication is on.




Keychain (Prerequisite)

- Remembers Passwords.
- Synchronizes across devices.
- Autofills information.
- End-to-End encryption.



1. Tap Settings
2. Tap your name
3. Tap iCloud



4. Tap Passwords

5. Turn on Sync this iPhone




Passkey Upgrades

3. Tap Passwords




