Apple Cash



Wallet

Apple Cash is managed in the Wallet app.

- A mobile peer-to-peer digital money service by Apple.
- Pay merchants, send, request & store cash with Apple.
- Both sender & receiver use iPhones and Messages.
- Debit card from your bank is linked to the account.


- iPhone must be signed into your Apple Account.
- Apple Cash is only available for use in the U.S.
- Two-Factor authentication must be turned on.
- Passcode, Touch ID or Face ID used.

- Connect a Debit card with your bank.

Use Apple Cash in Messages




Open Message app & desired message

Tap the +



Using Tap to Cash




Open the Wallet app


Enter Person

Tap Next




Using Tap to Cash
