

# Live Text - iPhone - iOS 18

## Live Text



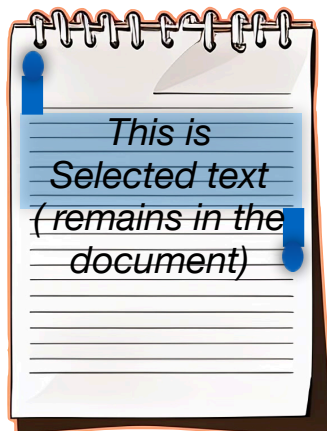
A XS, XR or newer iPhone with iOS 15 or later is needed to have Live Text.

- Live Text is used to extract information from photos, videos, and images.
- There is no Live Text app or a Control Center feature.
- It's integrated into the Photos, Camera, Safari and other apps.

- Live Text uses the Copy, Paste & Clipboard feature.
- Copy: Duplicates selected content w/o removing it.
- Paste: Inserts content you've cut or copied to new or different location.

## Copy & Paste

1. Select



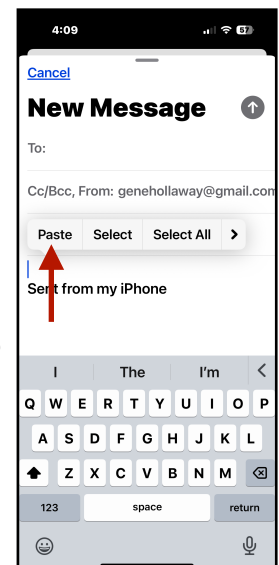
The selected text remains on the original document.

2. Copy



3. Paste

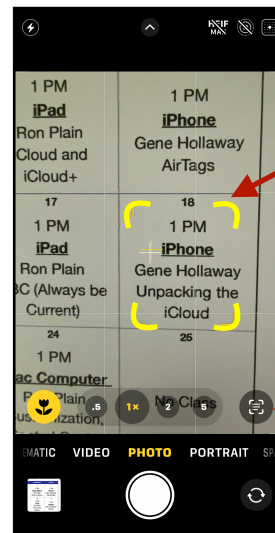
Tapping the insertion point (cursor) the Paste menu appears.

Assume information on a document is needed to place in an email.

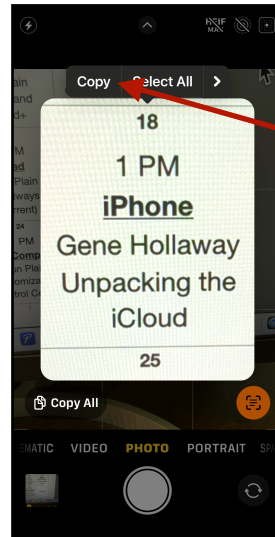
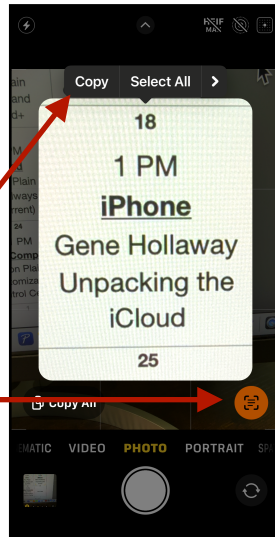
Open camera, move around until desired text is bracketed in yellow.

When text is recognized, Live Text icon will appear.

## Copying Text

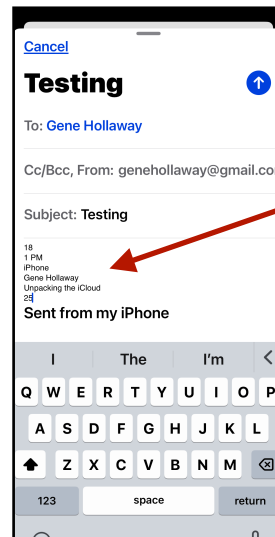
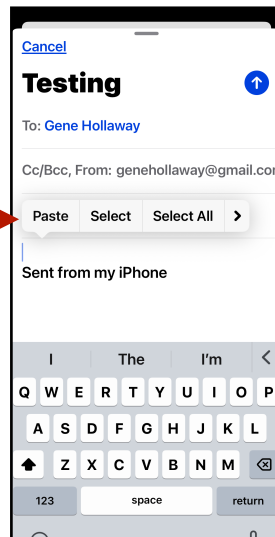
*Tapping the Live Text icon will bring up menu options.*



*Tap Copy, this will copy selection to the virtual Clipboard.*

## Pasting Text in Email

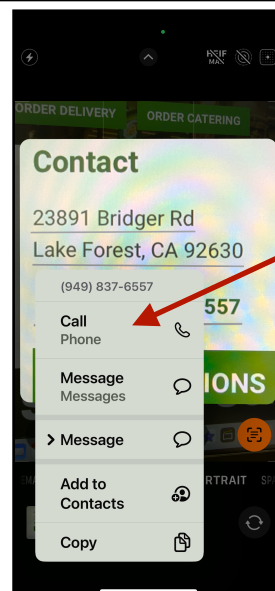
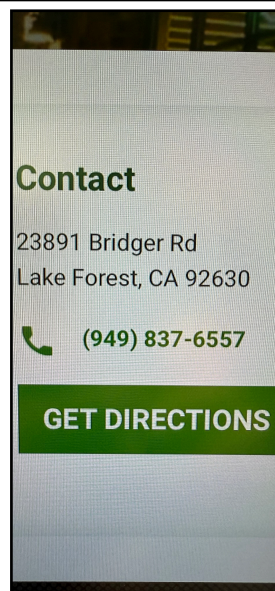
*Tapping the cursor brings up menu. Tap Paste.*



*Selected Live Text pasted into another app.*

## Making a Phone Call

*Position camera to allow Live Text to select a phone number.*



*Tap Live Text icon then tap call.*
